Programme

Join us this summer for our International Summer School and experience a unique study experience in one of the most beautiful regions of the UK at one of the top universities.

Our International Summer School starts with a 5-day cultural programme in London which



includes lectures delivered by some of our world leading academic colleagues. Our Future Impact Workshop Series aims to introduce you to the University of Exeter and our priorities. This will help you to understand our academic courses in context and the way we live and work on our campuses, both in Devon and Cornwall. At the end of the first week, you will be transferred by coach to our main Streatham Campus in Exeter.

Fees

The standard fee is £3,750 which covers the London programme, the academic tuition, accommodation both in London and Exeter, and some social activities.



Entry Requirements

You are eligible to join the programme if you are 18 years old by the start of the programme and meet the entry requirements in the two following categories:

Academic Standards Entry Requirement

Our courses are a mixture of introductory levels up to pre-master level courses but do not require applicants to be studying on a particular course before applying. It may be beneficial to have a background in the area, particularly on our more science-based courses like Preventative Medicine, but this is not a requirement. All lectures take place in Building One which is home to the prestigious University of Exeter Business School.



Anyone can apply for the courses providing you are able to prove a GPA of 3.0 out of 4.0 or above (or equivalent in their own country). For students who have yet to complete their first year or who are looking to try this before starting a degree programme, please contact iss@exeter.ac.uk to discuss entry requirements in more detail.

If you are unsure if you meet the entry requirements, you can email us to check or just apply and we will let you know if you have been successful. If you are not successful, we will contact you with regards to what you need to do next to gain a place on the programme.

English Language Requirement

The University of Exeter standard English Language Level requirements apply to this programme and details of the range of qualifications that are accepted can be found here

Below is an overview of basic guidelines for applying and if you are unsure whether any of these apply to you, then you should email iss@exeter.ac.uk to confirm.

Basic English language level requirements:

- If you reside in a country for more than three months where English is a widely spoken or native language. This includes short term study where the course has lasted for 3 months or more.
- If you come from an English-speaking country.
- You must have a letter or transcript from your place of study to confirm that the course you have studied in your institution is taught exclusively in English (excluding English language courses).
